## DUAL2DEGREE

### Requirements

- Juniors and Seniors can participate in Dual Enrollment. Exceptions (i.e. Freshmen and Sophomores) are reviewed on an individual basis.
- All students have to meet minimum requirements to participate:

STARR (Level 2 End of Course Exam)	
English II	4000
Algebra II	4000
STARR (Level 1 End of Course Exam)	
Algebra I	4000 & "C" or better on Algebra 2 high school course

TSI Assessment	
Reading	351
Writing	Essay score of 5 or Essay score of 4 & Multiple Choice of 363
Math	350

*Dual Enrollment testing prerequisites are subject to change. Some courses may require different or additional prerequisites. For a complete list of testing prerequisites please see your high school dual enrollment contact.*

### Admissions Process

Step 1: Complete a Dual Enrollment Admissions Application. Apply online at [www.applytexas.org](http://www.applytexas.org).

Step 2: Provide STC a copy of your high school transcript; include current TSI scores.

Step 3: Meet with your high school counselor to select and register for Dual Enrollment classes.

### Step 1: Creating a Profile

- Go to [www.applytexas.org](http://www.applytexas.org) and click [Create your account now »](#)
- Complete all fields marked **required**.
- Please note the following information:
  - **Suffix** means if your name (for males) ends with Jr., III, etc.
  - Under **place of birth**, select a country **if not United States**.
  - If your **ethnicity** is Hispanic/Latino, your race is **white**.
  - Unless you live and receive mail in different places, **only fill out the permanent address portion**.
  - When entering your phone number **do not** use parentheses, spaces, dots, or dashes. Numbers only.
  - Leave the **preferred phone country code** blank.
  - For Emergency Contact only enter a name and phone number.
  - Your **password** must be at least 8 characters long and it must contain at least one number.
  - You must select and answer five different password reset questions.
- Click [save profile](#) on the bottom of the page. Your errors will be noted in **red** at the top of the page: **You must correct the errors to continue**. You may also be asked to verify information; click the [blue link](#) to take you to what needs verification; check the ☐ then save your profile again.
- Once your profile is saved, a username will be assigned. **Write down your username and the password you created for future reference.**

## Step 2: Completing the Application

1. Click the **My Applications** tab, then click [Create a new application now.](#)
  2. Click [create a new 2 year college admissions application](#)
  3. In **either list** select South Texas College (McAllen) as the **target college**.  
Select **“NO”** when asked if the application is for dual credit classes.
  4. Select Fall (Aug - Dec) 2016 as the **semester of entry**. Click continue.
  5. Select **Interdisciplinary Studies** as **first choice major**. Do not select a second choice. Click continue, then click “continue to my application”.
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### Page 1 of 5 - Biographical Information

6. **If you know it**, enter your social security number. If not, **skip** it.
  7. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click [save changes](#)
  8. If you receive a message (a [blue link](#)) to verify information, click the link.  
It will take you to what needs to be verified.
  9. Click the ☐ button to verify the information, then scroll down to the bottom of the page and click [save changes](#) again.
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### Page 2 of 5 - Educational Background

10. For question 1 on this page, first click [Find Your High School](#)
  - A pop-up should appear. Enter your school name and city then click **submit**. Select your school from the results. This should fill in all the information on your application.
  - Enter your **expected graduation date** (month and year).
11. Answer **no** for “Are you home schooled?”
12. **Skip** questions 2, 3, and 4.
13. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click [save changes](#)

*Note: If there are any errors you will be informed of them after you click “save changes”. The [blue links](#) that appear at the top of the page will take you to the errors. You must correct all errors before you can continue.*

  16. For Question 3, **Reason Attending**, select Earn Associate Degree

  19. Answer the three residency questions. Most students will select “Texas” as the state of residency, then ☐ **Yes** to **both** of the following questions. Click “[save and continue to next question](#)” then click “[save page and continue with application](#)”.
