- **Deadline:** October 6, 2017
- **Award:** (10) ranging from \$500 to \$1500
- **Requirements:** Ages 14 to 22, Create an original work showcasing your idea for a solution or strategy to fix the very real problem of reckless and distracted driving.

- **Requirements:** Be a U.S. Citizen, strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor’s degree, \$55,000 or lower adjusted gross family income is required, be involved in co-curricular and community service, and GPA of 2.0
