



SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE: OCTOBER 30, 2017

DEADLINE: FRIDAY - MARCH 30, 2018 by 4:00pm CST

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for a Diamondback Athletic Booster Club Scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

Student Criteria

- Must be a graduating Senior athlete at PHS in the Class of 2018
- Must be a Letterman in at least one sport
- Must be graduating in good standing (Principal, Asst. Principal and Counselor will be asked to sign application).
- Must write an original essay for the topic assigned.
 - Essay Prompt: "How Playing Sports at Pioneer High School Has Prepared Me For College"
- Must be enrolled in an institute of higher learning (Verification not required to apply, but is required before funds are disbursed).

Parent Criteria

- Student's family must be an active member of the Diamondback Athletic Booster Club with paid annual dues AND volunteer for 10 hours each academic year for a minimum of two (2) consecutive years, to include student's senior year.
- **Parents of 2017-2018 Seniors must be paid members for 2017-2018 for your child to be eligible.**
- **Student's family must volunteer for Ten (10) hours selling concessions or merchandise (football/volleyball/basketball games, fundraisers, events).** Members who are signed up are included on weekly emails listing volunteer opportunities. *Volunteer Opportunities listed on DABC website.*
- **Student's family must attend at least 5 DABC meetings for 2017-2018.**

TO APPLY:

1. **Pick up your application from the Go Center, fill out and obtain necessary signatures.**
2. **Make sure parents are paid, registered members of DABC online at www.diamondbackbooster.org**
3. **Make sure parents complete volunteer hours by May 11, 2018.**
4. **Write essay, topic is "How Playing Sports at Pioneer High School Has Prepared Me For College".**
5. **Submit your completed application and essay to Ms. Zuniga or Mrs. Wheeler in the Go Center.**

If you are an athlete at PHS and are a:

- Graduating Senior;
- Lettering in at least one sport your senior year;
- Graduating in good standing;
- Plan to enroll in an accredited college or university in the Fall semester after graduation
