Sharyland Pioneer High School National Honor Society- Selection Criteria

The following selection criteria will be used for selection to the Sharyland High School, Sharyland Pioneer High School, and Sharyland Advanced Academic Academy National Honor Society.

Part I: Required Criteria

All candidates must fulfill all three parts of the following before consideration for selection to the National Honor Society.

1. For acceptance into NHS, candidates must apply the fall of their junior year in high school.
2. All candidates must have completed 6 Pre-AP/AP/ DC and must be enrolled in at least 1 Pre-AP/AP/DC class before being inducted to the National Honor Society.
3. GPA: 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
4. All candidates must complete all parts of this application packet.
5. Beginning 2020-2021, 10th grade students may apply only if they have met the following:
 - a. NHS member in SISD
 - b. Successfully complete 4 or more Pre-AP/AP/DC in high school
 - c. Complete all parts of the application

Part II: Earning Additional Points

Candidates may earn additional points from one or more of the following listed below:

1. No loss of credit per year = 1 point per year
2. 4 or fewer absences per year = 5 points
3. No negative teacher comments = 3 points
 - a. Any negative teacher comments eliminate the opportunity for the 3 points.
4. No failing grades per year = 1 point per year.
5. Successfully passing 4 out of 5 End of Course exams- English I, English II, Biology, and Algebra= 1 point.

Part III: Student Reconsideration

A student may be “reconsidered” for membership to National Honor Society by following the criteria listed below:

1. Consult with the NHS Committee Lead Sponsor. A student who would like to request an Appeal for acceptance to NHS, must meet with the NHS Lead Sponsor for their designated campus. The Lead sponsor may clarify the nature of the selection process or the decisions that were made regarding the selection process. If the student would still like to appeal the decision, the Lead Sponsor will inform the student on the formal process for appeals.
2. Filing out a Formal Appeal. A Student may appeal the decision of the NHS selection committee based on one (1) of the following reasons.
 - a. Technical or Procedural Errors: (i) May include the inadvertent omission of a student’s name from the list of those qualified for induction, (ii) the erroneous averaging of grades, (iii) the chapter’s failure to follow prescribed procedures.
 - b. Appeals of non-selection will not be rated for re-evaluation of essays, or for reasons related to the failure of a candidate to include information that was not submitted during the initial selection process.
3. All appeals are heard by the NHS Lead Sponsor and a committee member.
4. Upon receipt of the decision not to induct a candidate, a student may make a written appeal to the NHS selection committee and the building principal. The appeal must be made in written form. No appeals will be heard by the NHS Lead Sponsor prior to the official notification of non-selection.
5. The request for an appeal must state the reason for the appeal.
6. An appeal must be registered with the NHS Lead Sponsor within two (2) weeks after the notice has been given not to induct a candidate.
7. The NHS Lead Sponsor and a committee representative elected by the Lead Sponsor will schedule a hearing for the appeal.
8. The NHS selection committee and the building principal will hear the appeal, investigate the concerns presented, and notify the appellee of their decision in written form within two (2) weeks of the date of the appeal. However, there may be extenuating circumstances which require more time for the investigation of the appeal. If more time is needed, the NHS Sponsor will notify the appellee in written form and give an estimated date for their notice of decision.

Part IV: Causes for Dismissal from NHS

A student may be subject for dismissal from NHS for but not limited to the following reasons:

- a. Violation of the SISD Student Code of Conduct
- b. Failing 2 or more courses per semester
- c. Failure to attend 50% or more of regularly scheduled NHS meetings
- d. Academic dishonesty
- e. Lying on community service hours
- f. Failure to maintain community service hours each year
 - i. Minimum of 30 hours junior year
 - ii. Minimum of 30 hours senior year
- g. Failure to turn in community service hours to NHS Lead Sponsor each year
- h. Permanent loss of credit due to non-compliance of SISD Attendance Policy
- i. 4 or more absences may cause dismissal from NHS- Campus attendance committee will review excessive absences for all members from each grade level
- j. Failing to successfully complete ALL EOC examinations

A student in the final semester before graduation, who violates any of the above infractions, will not receive NHS stole.

Part IV: Appeals of Dismissal Cases

A student may appeal a decision for dismissal from NHS. A student will be required to submit a written request for a hearing to appeal a dismissal to the NHS Lead Sponsor within two (2) weeks after the dismissal.

Part V: Interview

As part of the selection process, a student will be required to participate in an interview for NHS. There will be 3 questions asked at the interview. You will have to respond to questions about your experiences with regard to Scholarship, Leadership, Character, and Service. Appearance, preparedness, enthusiasm, verbal communication, quality of answers, nonverbal communication and posture will also be rated during the interview process.
