Prudential Spirit of Community Awards

- **Deadline:** November 5, 2019
- **Award:** \$1,000 and a trip to Washington D.C
- **Requirements:** be in grades 5-12 as of November 5, be a legal resident of any U.S. state, have engaged in a volunteer activity that occurred during the 12 months prior to the date of the application, submit a completed application to a school or the head of an official designated local organization by November 5.

Most Valuable Student Scholarship Award

- **Deadline:** November 5, 2019
- **Award:** 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2020 competition.
- **Requirements:** Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need. Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply. Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.

- **Award:** \$2,500-\$10,000
- **Requirements:** The Anne Ford and Allegra Ford Thomas Scholarships offer financial assistance to two graduating high school seniors with documented learning disabilities and/or ADHD who are pursuing post-secondary education.

- **Requirements:** Students will conduct a research in the fields in math and science and then will present their findings to judges.

Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program

- **Deadline:** November 13, 2019
- **Award:** This highly competitive scholarship includes up to \$40,000 per year to attend a four-year accredited undergraduate school.
- **Requirements:** Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements: senior standing, fall college enrollment, GPA of 3.5 or above, receive a minimum SAT total of 1200 or ACT composite of 26, and must demonstrate unmet financial need. They will consider applicants with family income up to \$95,000.
