Catalog Course Description:

The first semester of this class emphasizes biochemistry, cell structure and function, cellular transport and the cell cycle, DNA and genes, and the basics of genetics and inheritance patterns. The second semester emphasizes the principles of evolution, ecology, classification of plants and animals, viruses and bacteria, body systems, and the dissection of the fetal pig.
